Internet Policy

The Library director with the advice of the library Board of Trustees may establish rules, time limitations, usage schedules, and the like for use of the library's workstations.

Individual users are responsible to observe relevant Federal, State, and local laws including, but not limited to, copyright, damage to equipment and software, and illegal content.

You do need to have a basic knowledge of computers.

The computers will be used on a first come, first serve, basis.

Time will be allotted, as authorized by librarian.

In the event you damage the equipment or programs, you will pay the cost to repair or replace the equipment or software.

The computers shut down 15 minutes before the library closes.

Only the computer user will be at the computer station except for adult assistance to minors.

If you fail to comply to the above policy you will lose your Internet privileges.
