July 6, 2023


The Mayor and City Council of the City of Syracuse, Nebraska met at Syracuse City Council Chambers located at 495 Midland Street Syracuse, Nebraska at 4:00 P.M. on July 6, 2023 for a special meeting. Notice of meeting was given by posting in five places. Mayor Dettmer requested roll call; present were Mayor Dettmer and Council members Orv Gigstad, Jerry Werner, Nate Patton; Wesley Halvorsen absent. A copy of the posting notice and acknowledgement of notice to the Council is attached to these minutes. Minutes for the June 14th, 2023 meeting were approved as written. Availability of the agenda was communicated in the advance notice. All proceedings hereafter shown were taken while the meeting was open to the public.
